For practical reasons, not all proposals for volunteerism can be approved. Proposals must be approved by site coordinator and building administration before student can attend. PKA ends at 5:30. Students must be picked up by that time. A fee for late pick up may be assessed *and must be paid before the student(s) can return to attend the program.*

Circus/Acrobatics - Portland juggler Janoah "anygoodjokes?" Bailin and the Denmark Arts Center's Delaney McDonough team up for a silly and energetic extravaganza! Learn juggling, clowning, handstands, cartwheels, and team acrobatics.

Collage In this art class, students will learn what collage is and explore the many methods to create these assembled images.

Cooking with Chef Wow for 3rd, 4th & 5th graders. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! **Limit of 12**

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. *All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.*

Container Gardening Each week we'll plant something new, using containers we create using recycled and new materials.

Cubetto for Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd graders. Cubetto is a little wooden robot designed for young children to help them learn the basics of computer programming. It doesn't use a screen, but comes with a set of instruction blocks that equate to a coding language you can actually touch. Coding can be fun and easy.

Guitar Lessons for 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th graders. Mountain Top Music Center will provide music lessons for PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis.

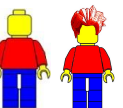
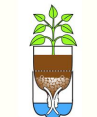
Not-So-Bored Games Students will get a chance to learn and play a variety of fun and exciting board games, some new and some very old, some small and some quite big.
