PKA ends at 5:30. Students must be picked up by that time. A fee for late pick up may be assessed *and must be paid before the student(s) can return to attend the program.*

November & December Afternoon Activities

Alpine Zone Weather with WMO for K, 1st & 2nd Graders. Discover the Alpine Zone of Mount Washington with Will Broussard from Observatory Staff and find out what it takes to survive hurricane force winds, freezing temperatures, and heavy snowfall. Think you have what it takes? Think again!

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. *All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.*

Cooking with Chef Wow for 3rd, 4th & 5th. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! **Limit of 12 students**

Cubetto for K thru 2nd graders. Cubetto is a little wooden robot designed for young children to help them learn the basics of computer programming. It doesn't use a screen, but comes with a set of instruction blocks that equate to a coding language you can actually touch.

Fairy Tale Puppet Theater for K thru 2nd graders An exploration of classic fairy tales from all cultures through storytelling and interactive puppetry performance.

Guitar Lessons for 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th graders. Mountain Top Music Center will provide music lessons for PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis. This class runs simultaneously with Computer Club so be sure to choose another Enrichment Activity for Fridays.

Holiday Crafts - Create fun crafting projects for the holidays.

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Robotics for 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th graders. This session we will work exclusively with our Lego Robotics kits (for second graders and up) so you can build and program your own robots! **Limit of 16 Students**

Native American Crafts - for 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. Learn a variety of traditional Native American crafts. Depending upon student interests, projects may include beadwork, dream catchers, masks, rattles, rainsticks or basic leather working.

Not-So-Bored Games Students will get a chance to learn and play a variety of fun and exciting board games, some new and some very old, some small and some quite big.

Origami All it takes is a little square of paper, some concentration and patience to learn the art of paperfolding.

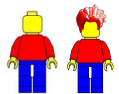
Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.
