November & December Afternoon Activities

Bookbinding Learn how to make your own handmade books, from simple folding and cutting pages, to stitching together pages, binding and making a hardcover.



Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart.



All students attending on Fridays will be in this class

Cooking with Chef Wow for 2nd 3rd & 4th grade. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week



Limit of 12.

Cubetto for K thru 2nd graders. Cubetto is a little wooden robot designed for young children to help them learn the basics of computer programming. It doesn't use a screen, but comes with a set of instruction blocks that equate to a coding language you can actually touch.



Duct Tape for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade Duct tape was created as a makeshift adhesive, but the things you can do with it are endless. Come join us for an afternoon exploring the possibilities. Bring your imagination, as we will spend time coming up with our own creations.



Guitar Lessons for 2nd through 4th graders. Mountain Top Music Center bringing music lessons to PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis.



Holiday Crafts Create fun crafting projects for the holidays.



Jewelry Making for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. Learn to create your own necklaces, bracelets, rings and even pins while using various techniques for working with beads, wire, various cords and findings (jewelry making hardware). **Limit of 15.**



Just Dance This will be a group experience to explore a variety of dance styles and learn some dance moves using our Wii. Get up, have fun and just dance!



LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.



LEGO Motorized Machines for 2nd through 4th grade students. These sets have hands-on activities that will develop a students' understanding of basic physical science concepts such as gears, pulleys, levers, and wheels and axles through observation, reasoning, prediction, and critical thinking. **Limit of 8 students.**



Little Engineers for K to 2nd Graders We'll discover how things work and attempt engineering challenges using everyday objects.



Nature Club for 2nd 3rd & 4th grade. Meet the great outdoors. Take our guided tour with the staff of the Tin Mountain Conservation Center and discover what's happening just outside our door.



Not-So-Bored Games Students will get a chance to learn and play a variety of fun and exciting board games, some new and some very old, small and some quite big.



Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.



Way Cool Science for Kindergarten through 2nd Grade. Be prepared for the fun, excitement, and surprises of hands on science. This could get messy...



Woodworking for 2nd 3rd & 4th grade. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood with carpenter Jeremy Twombly-Wiser. **Limit of 12.**



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
