November & December Afternoon Enrichment Activities

Bookbinding Learn how to make your own handmade books, from simple folding and cutting pages, to stitching together pages, binding and making a hardcover book.

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart.

All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.

Cooking with Chef Wow for Kindergarten & 1st grade. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week!

Limited to 12 .

Gym Games An exploration of cooperative as well as competitive group games for children.

Holiday Crafting Create fun crafting projects for the holidays.

Just Dance This will be a group experience to explore a variety of dance styles and learn some dance moves using our Wii. Get up, have fun and just dance!

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Motorized Machines for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. These sets have hands-on activities that will develop elementary students' understanding of basic physical science concepts such as gears, pulleys, levers, and wheels and axles through observation, reasoning, prediction, and critical thinking. *Limited to 16 students.*

Little Engineers for Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade. We'll discover how things work and attempt engineering challenges using everyday objects.

Loom Knitting for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. Knitting on a loom is the easiest way to learn to knit. We will build our own knitting loom and knit some small projects.

Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

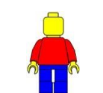
Rhythm & Songs for Kindergarten & 1st grade. In our class for drums and songs children will enjoy singing songs with Sharon and playing together on various instruments (drums, sticks, xylophones, maracas). The class will adapt to interests of children in the class- more singing for some classes/ more instruments playing for others.

Tinkering for 3rd & 4th Graders - Learn about circuit boards - We'll take apart some everyday items and see what makes them tick - sew a circuit board, make a light up Holiday card, and design and create your own scribble machine. This will be an opportunity to be creative and "think with your hands."

Way Cool Science for Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade. Be prepared for the fun, excitement, and surprises of hands on science. This could get messy...

Wild Life with Tin Mountain for 3rd & 4th grade. This PKA session will focus on getting kids out and about and thinking about wildlife. We'll learn about, search for (outside), and experience all kinds of local creatures and their ways. Birds, mammals, and even beetles. Indoor time will utilize animal mounts, skins, insect collections, fossils, skeletons, and reading to learn and explore. Weather permitting, students will go outside to look for animal tracks and signs or play animal themed games. Please remember to send your children dressed for the outdoors!

Woodworking for 3rd & 4th grade. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood. *Limited to 10 students.*



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
