March & April Afternoon Enrichment Activities

All Things Amphibian with Tin Mountain for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. What is an amphibian? How can they live in Maine? Where do they go when it gets cold? Why do they sing?

Animation Explore animation through thaumatropes, flip books & computer stop motion and more.

Arts & Crafts Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can produce.

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart.

All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.

Cooking with Chef Wow for Kindergarten & 1st grade. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! **Limited to 12 students.**

Duct Tape for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. Duct tape was created as a makeshift adhesive, but the things you can do with it are endless. Come join us for an afternoon exploring the possibilities. Bring your imagination, as we will spend time coming up with our own creations.

Graphic Novels for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. Learn how to create your own characters and develop a story for them. We will begin with a small comic strip and see where we can go.

Gym Games An exploration of cooperative as well as competitive group games for children.

Just Dance This will be a group experience to explore a variety of dance styles and learn some dance moves using our Wii. Get up, have fun and just dance!

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Motorized Machines for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. These sets have hands-on activities that will develop elementary students' understanding of basic physical science concepts such as gears, pulleys, levers, and wheels and axles through observation, reasoning, prediction, and critical thinking. **Limited to 12 students.**

Paper Zoo for Kindergarten & 1st grade. Learn fun animal facts while making animal crafts.

Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

Simple Stuffed Animals for Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade. Make your own stuffed animal. We will cut sew and decorate our own stuffed animal toy. **Limit of 12 students.**

Ukulele for 2nd 3rd & 4th grade. Sharon Novak of Mountain Top Music will be teaching this introduction to the ukulele, a fun and simple stringed instrument. Instruments will be provided. **Limit of 10 students.**

Woodworking for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood. **Limit of 10 students.**



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
