May and June Afternoon Activities

Arts & Crafts Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can produce.

Coin Rings for 4th and 5th grade. Turn money into jewelry. Each student will have a turn making their very own ring. Each student will start with a pre-drilled coin, then press, hammer and polish into a ring. The coins we use will be silver dimes or quarters. There will also be woodburning projects for the students to do while they wait. **Limit of 8**

Crochet for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. A beginners class in crochet. We will learn basic construction technique with simple crochet. **Limit of 10**

Garden Club Kindergarten & 1st grade. PKA students will be working with the School's Garden Project, learning about horticulture with Master Gardener Mrs. Buskin

Gym Games An exploration of cooperative as well as competitive group games for children.

Dinosaurs! for Kindergarten & 1st grade. Anything and everything dinosaur. We'll do some fun projects too!

Leather Craft for 3rd & 4th grade. Learn basic leather craft skills, stamping, hand stitching, dying and possibly design carving. For safety, students should be focused and committed to carefully following all directions. **Limit of 8**

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Robotics for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. This session we will work exclusively with our Lego Robotics kits (for second graders and up) so you can build and program your own robots! **Limit of 16**

Mysterious Magnetism for 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade. *The Science of Magnets -What is magnetic? What isn't? Hands on learning through exploring, observing, and figuring out the way magnetism works.*

Paper Planes Learn how to make a variety of paper airplanes from a simple sheet of paper. We will make planes that fly high, do loops, long distance gliders even a helicopter!

Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

Rhythm & Songs for Kindergarten & 1st grade. In our class for drums and songs children will enjoy singing songs with Sharon and playing together on various instruments (drums, sticks, xylophones, maracas). The class will adapt to interests of children in the class- more singing for some classes/ more instrument playing for others.

Wild Life with Tin Mountain for Kindergarten and 1st grade. We'll learn about, search for (outside), and experience all kinds of local creatures and their ways. Birds, mammals, and even beetles. Indoor time will utilize animal mounts, skins, insect collections, fossils, skeletons, and reading to learn and explore. Weather permitting, students will go outside to look for animal tracks and signs or play animal themed games. Please remember to send your children dressed for the outdoors!

Yoga for Kids Cats, Cobras and Camels, oh my! This program will explore celebrated yoga poses, breathing exercises and quiet meditation time all in kid friendly and exploratory format. Each class will end with "Chai Time" meant for sharing thoughts and developing good listening skills. **Limit of 17.**



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
