January & February Afternoon Activities

Archaeology Archaeology is learning about ancient peoples – how they lived, what they looked like, what tools they used, and what their cultures were like. Archaeologists are the scientists who study artifacts, man-made objects that people have left behind. We will take a look back at how people lived long ago.

Arts & Crafts Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can produce.

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. *All students attending on Fridays will be in this class*

Cooking with Chef Wow for Kindergarten & 1st grade. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! **Limit of 12.**

Guitar Lessons for 2nd through 4th grade. Mountain Top Music Center bringing music lessons to PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis.

International Club for Kindergarten & 1st grade Come and travel with us around the world. Experience what it is like to live in a very different place on another part of our planet. Discover about their weather, houses, stories, languages, foods, games, clothes and more.

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Robotics for 2nd, 3rd, 4th grade. This session we will work exclusively with our Lego Robotics kits (for second graders and up) so you can build and program your own robots! **Limit of 16**

Loom Weaving for 3rd & 4th grade. Committed students will learn the craft of weaving, Using a simple backstrap loom we will weave a scarf. **Limit of 10.**

Patchwork Quilting for 3rd & 4th grade. This class is an introduction to pieced quilting., We plan to work on a simple pieced pattern, explore the design variations available through a choice of fabrics and manipulation during assembly. We will be using the PKA sewing machines. We may even progress to quilting and binding a small piece, as time (and diligence) permits. **Limit of 8 students**

Planets for 3rd thru 4th grade. Come and learn about our neighbors in space.

Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

Simple Stuffed Animals for Kindergarten thru 2nd grade Make your own stuffed animal. We will cut sew and decorate our own stuffed animal toy.

Toy Making In this class we will be making fun and simple toys from everyday objects.

Winter Explorations with Tin Mountain for Kindergarten & 1st grade. We will explore our snowy environment in search of tracks and animal signs, study snowflakes, look at the winter constellations, and pursue knowledge and wonder for all things winter. Parts of class will be outdoors so please dress your kids warmly when they leave in the morning! Best of all we will be getting outside and have fun!

Woodworking for 2nd 3rd & 4th grade. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood with carpenter Jeremy Twombly-Wiser. **Limit of 12.**

Yoga for Kids for 3rd thru 4th grade. Cats, Cobras and Camels, oh my! This program will explore celebrated yoga poses, breathing exercises and quiet meditation time all in kid friendly and exploratory format. Each class will end with "Chai Time" meant for sharing thoughts and developing good listening skills. **Limit 17**
