## May & June Afternoon Activities

**Arts & Crafts** Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can produce.

**Beginner's Dance** This will be a small beginner's class to explore some basic dance styles and moves. **Limit of 10**

**Computer Club** Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. **All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.**

**Container Gardening** Each week we'll plant something new, using containers we create using recycled and new materials.

**Dinosaurs!** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Anything and everything dinosaur. We'll do some fun projects too!

**Endangered Neighbors** for 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Did you know there are 22 endangered species trying to live right here in Maine? Maybe have some fun learning about some of them while raising awareness.

**Graphic Novel** for 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Learn how to create your own characters and develop a story for them. We will begin with a small comic strip and see where we can go.

**Gym Games** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. An exploration of cooperative as well as competitive group games for children.

**LEGO Club** Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

**Lego Robotics** for 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade. This class will work exclusively with our Lego Robotics kits so you can build and program your own robots! **Limit of 16**

**Quiet Drawing** Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

**Rocks Rock!** for 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade. We will explore the inner and outer workings of the earth including the materials it is made from and the forces that shape it. Creating volcanoes? Cracking rocks open to see minerals they are made from? Traveling to the center of the earth? All of these things are a possibility in this program...except actually traveling to the center of the earth; that is impossible. Sign up and see what you can discover!

**Teaming with Insects** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. It's Spring and the bugs are back!, In this beginning entomology class and we are going to take a good close look at them.

**Ukulele** for 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Sharon Novak of Mountain Top Music will be teaching this introduction to the ukulele, a fun and simple stringed instrument. Instruments will be provided. **Limit of 10**

**Water, Water Everywhere** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. We will explore all about water. What is it? What does it do? Who lives in water? It is almost everywhere, even inside you!

**Woodworking** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood with carpenter Jeremy Twombly-Wiser. **Limit of 12.**

**Yoga for Kids** Cats, Cobras and Camels, oh my! This program will explore celebrated yoga poses, breathing exercises and quiet meditation time all in kid friendly and exploratory format. Each class will end with "Chai Time" meant for sharing thoughts and developing good listening skills. **Limit of 16**
