Parents are required to document their hours (with validated barter vouchers returned to PKA staff before the end of the session) in order to fulfill the requirements of their agreement.

*I propose to volunteer in the following manner:*

I recognize that failure to complete my agreement of 16 hours during the session will result in a default of the agreement. If this happens, I will be responsible for the entire cost of the session. For practical reasons, not all proposals for volunteerism can be approved. *Proposals must be approved by site coordinator and building administration before student can attend.* Be sure to submit your request early to allow for review.

PKA ends at 5:30. Students must be picked up by that time. A fee for late pick up may be assessed *and must be paid before the student(s) can return to attend the program.*

## September & October Afternoon Activities

**Arts & Crafts** Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can produce.

**Computer Club** Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. *All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.*

**Cooking with Chef Wow** for K thru 2<sup>nd</sup> graders. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! ***Limit of 12 students***

**Fairy Tale Puppet Theater** for K thru 2<sup>nd</sup> graders An exploration of classic fairy tales from all cultures through storytelling and interactive puppetry performance.

**Guitar Lessons** for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Mountain Top Music Center will provide music lessons for PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis. This class runs simultaneously with Computer Club so be sure to choose another Enrichment Activity for Fridays.

**LEGO Club** Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

**LEGO Robotics** for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> graders. This session we will work exclusively with our Lego Robotics kits (for second graders and up) so you can build and program your own robots! ***Limit of 16 Students***

**Nature Club** for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Come explore the great outdoors. Take our guided tour with the staff from the Tin Mountain Conservation Center and discover what's waiting just outside your door!

**Origami** All it takes is a little square of paper, some concentration and patience to learn the art of paperfolding.

**Random Acts of Kindness** Our kids can make a difference - We will be finding ways in which we can give back to our local community. We'll be focusing on projects for the local Nursing Home, our families, and our very own schools.

**PKA Sampler** This class is a sampler of the different things we do at PKA. Come and do something different every week!

**Quiet Drawing** Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

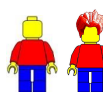

Mount Washington Observatory scientists work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to bring you the latest current conditions and weather forecasts for our area. But how do they do it? We'll learn the basics of weather and weather forecasting from the folks who live it every day.

**Woodworking** for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders - Jeremy is Back! Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood. ***Limit of 12 Students***

**Yoga for Kids** Cats, Cobras and Camels, oh my! This program will explore celebrated yoga poses, breathing exercises and quiet meditation time all in kid friendly and exploratory format. ***Limit of 14 Students***
