January & February Afternoon Activities

Computer Club Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart. *All students attending on Fridays will be in this class.*

Cooking with Chef Wow for K, 1st & 2nd Graders. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week! *Limit of 12.*

Guitar Lessons for 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. Mountain Top Music Center will provide music lessons for PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis. This class runs simultaneously with Computer Club so be sure to choose another Enrichment Activity for Fridays.

Just Dance - This will be a group experience to explore a variety of dance styles and learn some dance moves using our Wii. Get up, have fun and just dance!

LEGO Club Are you a LEGO maniac? If you feel there's never enough time to build or enough LEGOS you belong with us.

LEGO Motorized Machines for 2nd through 5th Graders. These sets have hands-on activities that will develop elementary students' understanding of basic physical science concepts such as gears, pulleys, levers, and wheels and axles through observation, reasoning, prediction, and critical thinking. *Limit of 8.*

Life at the Top for 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. Known as the Home of the World's Worst Weather, Mount Washington's winter conditions rival those of Mount Everest and the Polar regions. Did you ever wonder what it's like for the scientists living on top of Mount Washington? Now you can find out from someone who has actually lived there.

Little Engineers for k to 2nd Graders. We'll discover how things work and attempt engineering challenges using everyday objects.

Loom Knitting Knitting on a loom is the easiest way to learn to knit! We will build our own knitting loom and knit some small projects.

Myths & Legends for 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. Discover the myths and legends of cultures from around the world.

Paper Zoo for Kindergarten through 2nd graders. Learn fun animal facts while making animal crafts.

Patchwork Quilting for 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. This class is an introduction to pieced quilting., We plan to work on a simple pieced pattern, explore the design variations available through a choice of fabrics and manipulation during assembly. We will be using the PKA sewing machines. We may even progress to quilting and binding a small piece, as time (and diligence) permits. *Limit of 8.*

Quiet Drawing Students will explore drawing in a relaxed social setting, while working with pencils, pens and markers on a variety of paper surfaces.

Wild Winter for 3rd, 4th & 5th Graders. Crashing avalanches! Swirling Blizzards! Freezing temperatures! Winter can be harsh on the plants and animals (and on us!). We are going to explore these crazy winter events and how plants and animals survive through them.

Woodworking for K, 1st & 2nd Graders. Create fun and interesting projects while you learn about working with wood with carpenter Jeremy Twombly-Wiser. *Limit of 12.*

Yoga for Kids Cats, Cobras and Camels, oh my! This program will explore celebrated yoga poses, breathing exercises and quiet meditation time all in kid friendly and exploratory format. *Limit of 16.*
