



Woven Friendship Bracelets



1. Cut a cardboard circle (3" +/-)
2. Mark the center and four times across creating 8 radiating lines.
3. Cut each line in about 1"
4. Poke a hole through the center.
5. Cut 3 pieces of yarn each 5 feet long and one 2 1/2 feet (or 7 at 2 1/2 feet).
6. Fold the yarn in half, making a loop which you can pass your bead or button through. Add the short piece of yarn. Make an overhand knot and pull it tight. Test the loop to be sure your button will pass through!
7. Thread the 7 pieces of yarn up through the hole in the center of the cardboard circle
8. Slide each piece of yarn through a slot which leaves one slot empty. Place the empty slot at the bottom.
9. Count up three slots to the left and move that yarn down to the empty slot.
10. Move the empty slot to the bottom. Count up three slots to the left. Move the yarn to the empty slot.
11. Continue on until your bracelet is the desired length.
12. Remove the yarn from the slots and pull the bracelet out the center hole.
13. Make an overhand knot right at the end of your work and pull it tight.
14. Thread a button or bead onto the yarn.
15. Make another knot beside it.
16. Cut off the extra yarn.
