

## Ribbon Wands

Dowel or skewer with point cut off

Rubbons (to be cut 20" or more

Tape

Hot glue

Jingle bells (optional) and 4" piece of string or yarn

Thread the bell (or bells) on the string (or strings), yarn or narrow ribbon.

Even up the ends then tie a knot.

Cut several lengths of ribbon 20" (or longer).

Stack and slightly stagger the ribbons (1/2").

Place the string for the bell(s) on top of the first ribbon in the stack of ribbon ends.

Place your dowel so the bell(s) are off the end of the stick and the ribbons line up with the end of the stick.

Carefully apply hot glue to the ribbon ends and roll up the ribbons around the end of the dowel.



- A less expensive way is to use 6-7 36" strips of curling ribbon or a narrow ribbon and glue it onto both sides of one end the tongue depressor sized craft sticks. Then glue some ribbon around the area where you have glued to help give it a finished look and extra holding power. Use just one color or several colors.
