**Arts & Crafts** Explore your creative side! Use your hands and challenge your eyes. You may just be surprised by what you can create.

**Big Creepy Birds** Think you've seen them all? Maybe not...Come and learn about some the unusual creatures with which we share this earth.

**Cooking with Chef Wow** for 3<sup>rd</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> graders.. Fun and yum in the kitchen! You'll learn fun facts about foods and how to cook them. Discover a new recipe every week!

**Computer Club** Develop your computer skills. Have fun, play safe and play smart.

**Duct Tape** Duct tape was created as a makeshift adhesive, but the things you can do with it are endless.

Come join us for an afternoon exploring the possibilities. Bring your imagination, as we will spend time coming up with our own creations.

**Fairy Tale Puppet Theater** for K thru 2nd graders. An exploration of classic fairy tales from all cultures through storytelling with student interactive puppetry performance.

**Fall Harvest** Autumn is a time of harvest, come join us for an afternoon exploring what we can make out of that bounty. We'll create crafts and healthy snacks using Corn, Pumpkins, Apples, Sunflowers, and more.

**Go Green** What does "Going Green" mean? Learn about Reducing, Reusing, and Recycling! We add a 4<sup>th</sup> "R" that will be the most important one to know... Kids will do amazing projects that will integrate math, science, language arts, technology, health, engineering and creative art talents to find solutions for real world problems. "Green" concepts will be combined with creative activities for kids to enjoy!

**Guitar Lessons** for 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Mountain Top Music Center will provide music lessons for PKA. This experience allows students to learn basic guitar technique and play songs together. They learn to read music notation and lay the foundation for further music study. Instruments will be available for use during PKA, but space is limited and available on a first come first served basis.

**LEGO Robotics** for 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> graders. We have once again brought out our Lego Robotics kits (for second graders and up) so you can build and program your own robots!

**Myths & Legends** Discover the myths and legends of cultures from around the world.

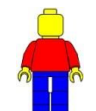

**Teddy Bear Workshop** for Kindergarten thru 2nd graders. Students will learn basic sewing and construction techniques to make their own stuffed Teddy Bear.
